IMPORTANT NOTE: Class size is limited to a maximum of 12 participants, per class. Early registration is encouraged. COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Lead RRP rule will require certification of contractors and maintenance staff performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint (LBP) and it will apply when renovators impact LBP in pre-1978 child-occupied facilities.

A renovator must complete an EPA-approved training course, and a firm must be an EPA certified. Initial training is eight hours in duration and includes hands-on exercises. Follow up refresher training is four hours and will be required once within each five year re-certification cycle. For more information, go to www.epa.gov/lead/.
